**Balnarring Foreshore Camping Reserves PARKS REGULATIONS.(part of )**

The committee of Management has the right to evict any person breaching the following regulations.

1. **ARRIVAL:** ALL campers must check at the Park office **BEFORE** setting up camp or occupying sites. **Sites may be occupied after 2pm on the day of arrival.**
2. **DEPARTURE:** Sites must be vacated by **12noon** on the day of departure or an additional fee may be charged.
3. **SPEED LIMIT:** maximum speed limit for all cars and bicycles will be walking pace.
4. **FAMILY PETS:** are forbidden on the reserve.
5. **NO FIRES/CAMP-FIRES:** including heat bead/coal permitted in the reserves or on the Foreshore.
6. **TOTAL FIRE BAN:** No FIRES in the open air Including Electric Fry pans or in annexes. (Caravans are not classed as Solid or permanent Dwelling as per CFA fire regulations)
7. **ALL CARAVANS:** Must have a Current operational Fire Extinguisher and Working Smoke Detector before camping on Crown Land.
8. **VEGETATION:** Campers must not remove, cut or damage trees and shrubs within the reserves. Tents, hammocks, washing lines may **NOT** be tied to trees. Please respect vegetation.
9. **SITES:** will consist of one caravan & annex and one small tent OR one large family tent and one small tent only. No solid annexes or structures permitted.
10. **CARPET IS NOT TO BE USED:** only small Hessian squares, shade cloth or commercial 'caravan matting' may be placed at entrance of tent or caravan.
11. **SITE FEES:** allow 2 adults and up to 3 children less than 18 years of age. Extra persons will incur a fee of \$10.00 per night. Notice of overnight visitors to be given to the Park Office.
12. **CARS: ONE CAR PER SITE** is permitted and it must display clearly the **current car permit**. **Visitors must not park in the Camping reserves.**
13. **WASTE WATER:** must be collected in buckets. It may be emptied around the base of trees on your site or disposed of in the storm water traps near the amenities block.
14. **HOUSEHOLD WASTE:** must be wrapped before being placed in the rubbish bins provided. **Recycling should be placed in the appropriate bin.**
15. **DRAINS, PITS OR TRENCHES:** **must not be dug around the camp site.**
16. **NO LOUD NOISE** Must be kept to a minimum after 10 pm and off at Midnight.
17. **CHILDREN: 6 and under** must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult while in the amenities block.
18. **POWER CONNECTION:** correct lead must be used. **NO** double adaptors and no additional extension leads may be used.
19. **CAMPING PERMIT:** No Permit shall be transferable.
20. **NO PERSON SHALL COMMIT ANY NUISANCE:** behave in a disorderly manner or disobey any direction indicated on any notice or sign in the Reserves, or lawful and proper direction by the Ranger.
21. **FIREWORKS:** it is illegal to possess or discharge ANY fireworks at ANYTIME .
22. **SHELLFISH:** and other rock fish are protected by law and must not be removed from the water.
23. **COMPLAINTS:** please refer to the Ranger/Manager Park Office or in writing to the **committee of Management.**
24. **SEASONAL SITES:** Must be removed by the Queens Birthday Long weekend in June each year, failure to do so will incur a Penalty fee of a daily rate per day and for each day there after. No seasonal sites may be occupied or caravans placed on site before September 1<sup>st</sup> each year by seasonal campers..
25. **The Committee of Management reserves the right to remove from the camping**, any caravan, camper-van, tent or vehicle which is in occupation of a site for longer than the period for which permission has been granted.
26. **The permit to occupy a site is revocable**, by the Committee of Management at any time on giving one hour's notice.
27. **The camping reserves are for the use of registered campers.**
28. **The camper(s) agree to re-imburse**, the cost of restoring or making good any loss or damage caused by them, any member of his/her group or any person visiting the Reserves at his/her invitation.
